# Canarm AgSystems adds NEMA 4X to their line of LED Agricultural Lighting Fixtures

Canarm AgSystems line of LED fixtures was originally developed for the AG industry with IP65 and IP66 ratings to ensure they could stand up to the environments they are being used in. They are very durable and sealed well enough to withstand pressure washing. That IP rating has recently been ignored by a few Canadian Electrical Inspectors in favour of a different rating; NEMA4X. The difference between IP66 and NEMA4X is only in one small phrase in their description. Nema spells out "resistance to corrosive materials" while IP only talks about how well sealed the fixture is.

Our fixtures have always been resistant to corrosion – we just happened to use a different test standard originally that did not really look at that aspect of the fixture. As codes change, we have to change as well to remain current in the ever-changing world of LED lighting. So we have submitted all of our fixtures for this added NEMA4X test, testing is underway and we will have the final

certifications in February 2019. This way we can continue to promote our line of quality LED Lighting products without any fear of on farm inspectors not accepting the product.

Make sure you send us a copy of any barn plans that you are working on in 2019 so that we can do up a free lighting design, layout and quote! Ensure you are getting ag rated lights by choosing an agricultural expert like Canarm AgSystems.
