


# Simple, cost effective watering tips to maximize milk production

A clean fresh water supply is one of the most important things you can provide for your herd. And even though it may be a very low cost input item, it should be viewed as one of the

most critical. There are several components to consider when reviewing your water supply but here are some of the most important to watch for.



- 1. 4-5 liters for every KG of dry matter intake or
- 2. 3.5-5 liters for every liter of milk produced

The second option is usually the easiest to calculate, since everyone follows output as one of the key production indicators for each cow.

With a herd average of 35 liters of milk per day,

that means you need to supply up to 175 liters of water per cow per day. About 50-60% of that intake of water occurs within 1 hour of being milked so not only do you need to consider volume but positioning becomes important as well.
